Overview:

The CHA 2018 Patient Safety Leadership Congress, Oct. 23, will address behavioral health gaps challenging hospitals and how these gaps affect the safety, quality and cost of care. Significant barriers exist around access, care coordination in and outside of the hospital walls, payment and workforce shortages. The program will highlight how new models of collaborative care, technology and integration with community providers can close some of these gaps.
