MAT can help save lives

- Medication-assisted treatment, in combination with counseling, has been shown to help people overcome opioid use disorders and prevent opioid overdose.
- By getting MAT trained, you'll make a real difference in your patients' lives, and your community.



PCSS provides free MAT waiver trainings online

- We provide free 8-hour MAT waiver training for physicians, NPs and PAs, and the additional 16-hour training for NPs and PAs.
- PCSS also includes podcasts and videos to equip clinicians to treat chronic pain, and a free coaching program that connects providers to experts for advice and counsel.



PCSS is endorsed by experts who treat addiction

- PCSS was created by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration (SAMHSA) and is administered by the American Academy of Addiction Psychiatry (AAAP).
