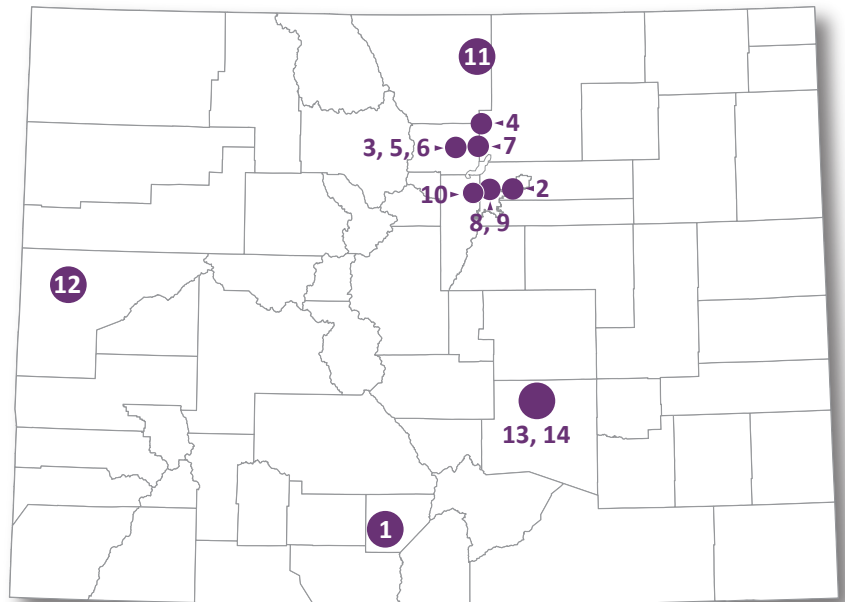


Colorado's Syringe Access Programs

Syringe access programs (SAPs) are a critical part of the continuum of care for many people battling addiction. Research demonstrates that syringe access is effective in preventing disease transmission (such as HIV and hepatitis C) and soft tissue infections, while also supporting the overall health of people who use drugs through access to health care, drug treatment, overdose prevention, housing and other social services. Services provided vary between SAPs, so it is important for providers to connect with their local SAP before referring patients. Common SAP services include:

- Injection supplies
- Basic physical assessments
- Safe disposal of used sharps
- Overdose education and prevention
- Testing and treatment for infectious diseases, including HIV, HCV and STIs
- Vaccinations
- Insurance eligibility evaluations
- Enrollment in assistance programs to access food, housing and work
- Behavioral health treatment
- Medication-assisted treatment
- Health care service
