
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How to set up an account

- Minimum of eight characters
 - Must include three of the following
 - Lowercase letters
 - Uppercase letters
 - Numbers 0 – 9
 - Any of the following special characters
 - !@#%&^*(){}[]
- Need to wait at least one day before it can be changed again
- Ten unsuccessful attempts will lock your username
 - Contact Support to reset

 - a. Click on the key icon, NOT the agency name.
 - i. If you click on the agency name, this will take you to a profile for that facility and overburden your information input process. We are not asking you to update all fields that you will see in a facility profile.
 - ii. We are only asking that you update all the fields shown once you click on the key icon.

6. Once you have all EEIs updated, scroll to the bottom of the form and hit Save.

Pediatric Vents Owned : The total number of hospital-owned pediatric ventilators (do not include anesthesia machines in OR). Include transport alarms suitable for longer-duration simple ventilation situations

Pediatric Vents Available: Total number of available pediatric ventilators not in use.

Vents Owned: The total number of hospital-owned ventilators (do not include anesthesia machines in OR). Include transport ventilators with high longer-duration simple ventilation situations

Vents Available: Ventilators available
