

Volunteer Cheat Sheet

- Staff volunteers
 - Anyone interested in volunteering should sign up through www.helpcoloradonow.com. There are a variety of opportunities both health care and non-health care volunteers can sign up to do, including virtual support, delivering food, medicines and medical supplies and helping those who live alone with daily tasks.
- Hotels
 - Hotels interested in donating or subletting their capacity to the COVID-19 response effort should contact Skip Feeney (Skip.Feeney@state.co.us), Medical Surge Support at the state Emergency Operations Center.
- Supplies/Equipment
 - Anyone interested in donating money, supplies or equipment, including food, PPE, cleaning supplies and medical equipment should sign up through www.helpcoloradonow.com. There is a link where they can fill out a form and the state will be in contact with them regarding their donation.
 - PPE: Please check if there are any PPE donation drives being hosted in your area. If there are none, many hospitals have donation bins where people can drop off any new and unopened PPE they wish to donate.
