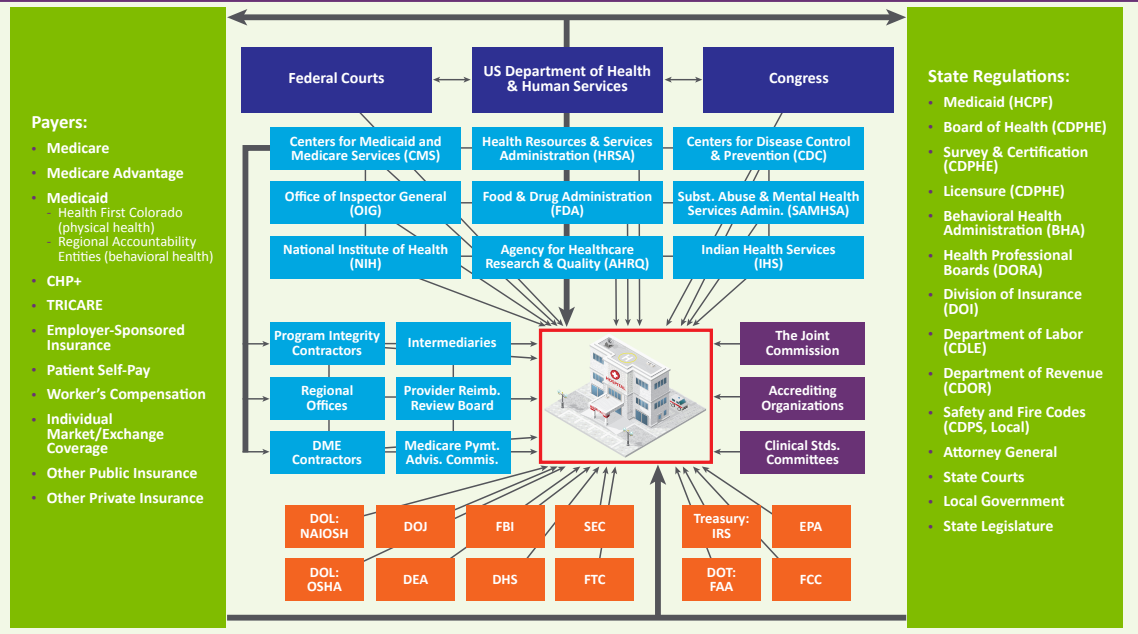




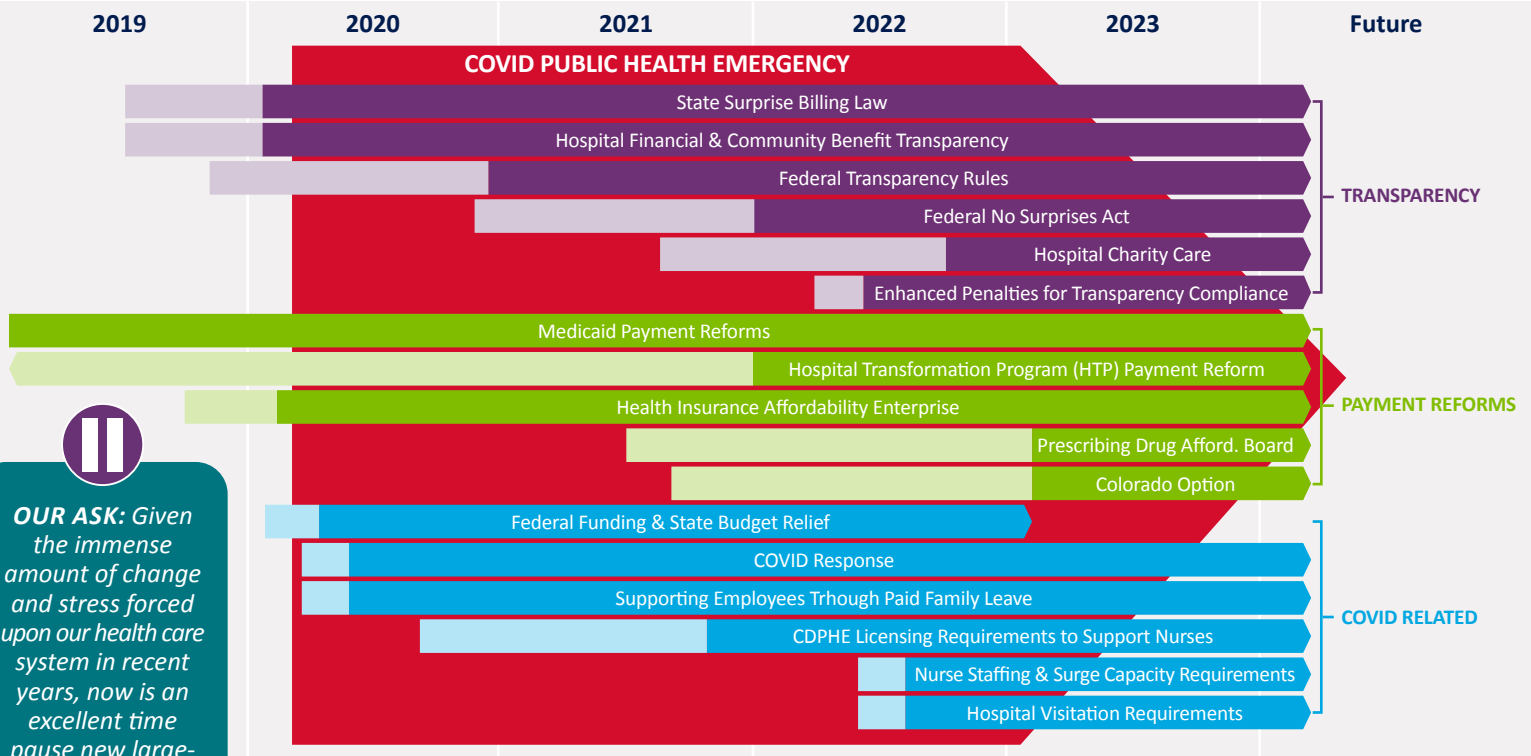
Hospitals and Regulatory Compliance
