More than \$1 billion invested by hospitals in strengthening the health care workforce since 2020

- Employee wellness
- Workforce development
- Tuition reimbursement/student loan assistance
- Pay increases
- Incentive bonuses

HOSPITALS: here for our *community*

More than \$1 billion in community investments in 2020

>11% of total hospital expenses invested in community benefit:

- 4.6% spent on community investments like social determinants of health
- 4.7% spent on unreimbursed Medicaid (compared to 2.9% nationally)
- 1.8% spent on charity care and free/discounted services

Hospitals are economic anchors

- \$40 billion total indirect economic impact
- \$4.9 billion indirect economic impact in rural Colorado

Hospitals train 1,300 physicians each year
