8:40 a.m.	Fraud, Abuse, and Antitrust Updates Government enforcement in the health care industry remains a top concern for providers. This session will provide a summary of key fraud and abuse cases and noteworthy settlements in 2023, preview enforcement trends for 2024 and beyond, and discuss how hospitals may be impacted by changing antitrust guidance from federal agencies.
9:20 a.m.	Public Option Update This past summer, the first public hearings mandated by the Colorado Option were scheduled by the Division of Insurance based on 30 allegations made against hospitals, yet all were ultimately vacated. This session will explore what happened and the implications for the future of the Colorado Option.
9:45 a.m.	Medicare, Medicaid, and Payment Update Medicare and Medicaid patients generally make up about two-thirds of a typical hospital's patient volume. This session will provide key updates on current state and federal activities impacting Medicaid and Medicare clients and providers, including audit activity and inpatient specialty drug reimbursement changes.

10:45 a.m.	Behavioral Health Reform Colorado is currently reforming its entire behavioral health system. With such huge transformation occurring, this session will provide a high-level overview of what hospitals should be tracking in this changing landscape, including changes to involuntary mental health hold standards starting Jan. 1, 2024.
