Proposed ballot initiatives threaten to make health care more expensive, harder to find and less safe in our state. Senate Bill 130 is the reasonable alternative.



Over the last 40 years, Colorado has enacted laws that increase patient safety, strengthen access to health care and contain costs. Now, a series of ballot measures proposed by trial lawyers would destroy these common-sense policies. There's a better way—Senate Bill 130. NO on Ballot Initiatives 150, 274, 275, 276 & 277

- Destroy safe spaces that promote patient safety in medical care.
- Eliminate reasonable limits on the amount of money an individual can collect when suing a health care provider.
- Drive up costs for health care providers and, in turn, patients.
- Result in many health care specialists opting out of higher-risk procedures and patient care, charging more for these services or leaving their practices altogether.

The devastating impact on Coloradans:

- Decreased access to care—particularly in rural and underserved communities.
- Even more expensive health care.
- Reduced health care quality and patient safety.



YES on SB-130: The Fair, Reasonable & Balanced Solution

- Increases the limit on how much an individual can collect when they win a lawsuit to a reasonable level, while still protecting health care for millions of Coloradans.

- Protects patients and the medical community, promoting access to high-quality, affordable health care for all Coloradans.
